Do we use any specific programme?



- REACh2 systematic phonics programme which is based on:
- Letters and Sounds
- Jolly Phonics (actions)
- Read, Write, Inc (writing rhymes)


- Develops children's speaking and listening skills and lays the foundations for the phonic work which starts in Phase 2.
- Phase 1 gets children attuned to the sounds around them and ready to begin developing oral blending and segmenting skills.









































Blending

- to draw individual sounds together to pronounce a word, e.g. s-n-a-p, **blended** together, reads snap.

Phonemes can be put together to make words. It is an individual sound.

Grapheme - A way of writing down a phoneme.

Graphemes can be made up from 1 letter e.g. p,


2 letters e.g. sh, 3 letters e.g. tch or 4 letters e.g ough




- Weekly spelling grid with newsletter- links to YouTube videos or videos sent out via Tapestry.
