#### Meet the Teacher Information Sessions

# Safeguarding

At Green Ridge we place a high emphasis on safeguarding our children at all times – both inside and outside of the school. As the named Designated Senior Person for Child Protection and Safeguarding, any matters about child safety or concerns you may have about a child or family should come to the immediate attention of myself. Mr English, our Deputy Headteacher, Mrs Mackie, our Assistant Headteacher and Mrs. Erdos, our School Business Manager are all Deputy Designated Senior Persons. We work jointly in all matters of safeguarding and if you need to speak to any of us, please make an appointment through the school office.

As an academy trust, we review our safeguarding procedures and systems regularly, and a copy of our Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy can be found on our website <a href="here">here</a>. It is important for us to maintain a clear record of anybody who is in the school for reasons of safeguarding as well as Health and Safety. Any parent/carer who needs to go beyond the foyer/entrance area will be asked to sign in and will be accompanied by a member of staff. Our accessibility toilet is for the convenience of our children and visitors to the school, and we kindly request that parents do not unnecessarily come into school to use this, unless in an emergency.

## Health and Safety

Just a reminder that the access into Green Ridge is via the pedestrian entrance, located to the left of the school site, which means walking past the vehicle entrance to get in. So that we can ensure that we keep everyone safe from any vehicles turning into the school drop-off zone, it's really important that parents, carers and children use the clearly marked pedestrian walk-way. For everybody's safety, please do not cut across the car entrance to the school to get to the playground.



### Start of Day Arrangements

School gates to the playground will be open from 8.30am, and children should not be on the school grounds before this time. Children will enter the school through their external classroom doors. Classrooms doors open at 8.40am and then close again at 8.50am; this allows parents to drop-off children at their convenience within this ten-minute window. Classroom doors are shut at 8.50am, and any child who arrives after this time will need to go through to the main reception area where they will be marked as 'late'. School playground gates will be locked at 9.00am and we respectfully ask parents and carers leave the school play areas by this time.

## End of Day Arrangements

School gates to the playground will re-open at 3.00pm each afternoon to allow parents and carers to come in and wait on the premises until their child is dismissed from class at 3.15pm. We ask that you wait in the respective play area for your child, and staff will release your child at 3.15pm when they know that a trusted adult is there to collect. Gates to the playground will again be locked at 3.30pm.

## **Key Diary Dates**

Tomorrow, you will receive list of school dates for the coming academic year. These dates are produced to allow parents and carers sufficient opportunity to plan around any specific events that may be happening where family members are invited to attend. Please note that any events marked in red denote that these are for parents/carers to attend, if they wish, and you are very much invited to. Ones marked in purple are specifically for new parents for September 2019 about starting school and applying for a school place. All other dates are for your information about what is going on each month in school. At the time of writing, some dates remain 'provisional' on the date list and are subject to change depending on what can be arranged. We will update you as soon as these are confirmed.

I am really looking forward to another very special and exciting year at Green Ridge, getting to know all of our new. You'll often find me or one of the leadership team outside in the mornings – on the gate or in the playgrounds; do come up and say hello as we try to learn everybody's names and faces, and if there is anything you want to ask or check, please do just ask.
