Key Questions

Why is the Bible important to Christians?	<i>The Bible is important to Christians because it teaches them about God and Jesus and gives them guidance on how to live their life.</i>
How does the Bible link to Christian worship?	<i>The Bible links in many different ways. One way is within Christian hymns as they often include different religious verses. The priest also uses the bible within their own sermons.</i>
What is the difference between The Gospels and proverbs?	<i>The Gospels are like biographies of the life of Jesus, while proverbs give wisdom and guidance.</i>
What different genres of writing are included within the Bible?	<i>The Bible includes, stories, poems, songs, proverbs, laws and letters.</i>
What language was the Old Testament originally written in?	<i>The old testament was originally written in Hebrew.</i>
How many different books are there in the Bible?	<i>There are 66 different books in The Bible.</i>
What is the first book of the Old Testament and the first book of the New Testament?	<i>The first book of the Old Testament is Genesis, while the first book of the New Testament is Matthew.</i>
