### Sequence of Learning

- The children will continue to develop their understanding of who Jesus was and his significance to the Christian faith in their Year Four unit titled *What do we know about Jesus?*









### Unit Sequence of Sequence of Learning

- The children will start the unit by learning about the life of Jesus. This includes revisiting previous lessons on the birth of Jesus, his death and resurrection.
- The next lesson focuses on what Jesus taught through parables. The example of the prodigal son is used.
- The use of parables continues within the next lesson where the children learn about the story of The Good Samaritan and the lessons Jesus was teaching through that story.
- Next, the children learn about how Jesus taught including the story of The Sermon on the Mount.
- The children then explore how Jesus taught through his actions.

### Key Questions

What are some of the key events in the life of Jesus?	<i>Children's responses may vary but could include retelling the Christmas story or discussing the death and resurrection of Jesus.</i>
What is a parable?	<i>A parable is a story that includes a lesson within it.</i>
What happens in the Prodigal Son story?	<i>See the outline below.</i>
What is the lesson Jesus was trying to teach with the story of <i>The Good Samaritan</i> ?	<i>Jesus was using the story to help explain that people should help others, regardless of what they may presume about them.</i>
How else did Jesus teach people, besides sermons and parables?	<i>Jesus also taught people through his actions such as when Jesus washed his disciples' feet.</i>
