### Sequence of Learning

Previously Children have learned about:

- The children have previously looked at different parts of the world in their Special Places unit within spring term.
- The children have also learned about the world within their Spring Geography unit which focuses on where different animals live.
- The children have also learned about the Story of Adam and Eve within the Autumn term.

**In future units the children will learn about:**

- In future RE units the children will learn about the wider world through their Year Five unit *Belief in Our Community* and within their Year Six unit, which teaches them about the Natural world.








### Unit Sequence of Sequence of Learning

- The children will start their learning by exploring different parts of the world. Within this lesson the children will make comparisons between these places and their own part of the world.
- The children will then learn about the Christian creation story.
- Next, the children will compare the Christian creation story to the Hindu creation story.
- They will then explore what different religions believe happens within the afterlife including how Christians, Muslims and Hindus describe heaven.
- The children's last lesson focuses on plants and how different religions explain how plants were created. This also includes the children learning about why plants are important.

| Which book in the Bible does the creation story come from?                   | <i>The book of Genesis.</i>   |
| Which religions have a similar creation story?                               | <i>Jews, Christians and Muslims have a similar creation story.</i>  |
| Who is Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva?   | <i>Brahma is the creator, Vishnu looks after the world and Shiva is the destroyer.</i>  |
| How is the Hindu creation story different from the Christian creation story? | <i>The Hindu creation story is different from the Christian creation story because Brahma created the world in the beginning of time.</i> |
