Raising the fundraising bar!

Thank you to all of you, bakers, buyers, sellers, doers and organisers for making the last school year our best yet!

Your hard work meant we managed to raise over £12,500 in 2019/20, compared to the £11,000 raised in the previous year, 2018/19. Which was even more than the year before! Please see the minutes from our AGM for a breakdown of events and the funds raised.

A fantastic achievement for everyone involved, especially given we couldn't fund-raise during the last term.

This year we are aiming even higher and with your help, we can smash it!

Enriching our children's learning journey

We work closely with the school to identify areas where extra funding can go a long way, like buying wet play equipment, continuing to grow our library or contributing towards improvements to our school's facilities.

Last year in addition to this we also spent over a £1,000 on new books, over £1,000 on the Christmas panto & author visits, and a new outdoor PA system.

As part of this total we have also received grants for among other items, to provide a reading shed for the playground thanks to Aylesbury Garden Town, a grant to provide travel to Bartlett's Home (once it is allowed again) and a new shed for the school.

We also hope, once able, to help towards the cost of the 11B411 experiences.
