#### What are we doing currently?

- We currently post YouTube videos where we introduce new learning for pupils and set challenges. Feedback is done via email when pupils/parents/carers send learning in.
- These videos allow us to model new learning and continue to follow our curriculum sequencing as normal.
- However, it does not allow us to easily share worksheets and the feedback process is cumbersome.

### Why are we changing from YouTube to

Teams?

 We recognise that many pupils may benefit from having access to additional resources (such as worksheets, scaffolds and word banks). It is not possible to share these via YouTube but is very simple over Teams.

- It makes it easier for pupils to complete/submit learning (much of which can be done directly within Teams or you can print from there if you have the option to)
- We want to streamline the feedback process so that pupils receive high quality feedback and next steps without the hassle of having to send an email each time.

#### When will this happen?

• We are staggering our transition to Microsoft Teams to ensure that our remote learning can continue uninterrupted.

Year 5 have begun using it already.

• Other year groups will be informed via letter when this change will happen for them. The plan at the moment is for Year 1 to transition to teams week commencing 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021.



### How do I get set up on Teams?

#### Step 1: Download Teams

Smartphones and tablets: Download the free Microsoft Teams app

iOS devices (iPhones, iPods, and iPads)	Android devices

Computers and laptops: Download Microsoft Teams

Your child needs to:

- Go to <u>www.microsoft.com/en-gb/microsoft-365/microsoft-teams/download-app</u>
- Click 'Download Teams'
- Once it's downloaded, click on the installer to run the app
- Log in to their Office 365 account




### How do I get set up on Teams?

#### Step 2: Login

- Each pupil already has an account set up that is linked to their Year group team.
- Each child's username will follow the pattern of a number (19 for Y1) followed by their forename and then the first letter of their surname.
- e.g. 19MichaelF@greenridgeacademy.co.uk
- Each child's password will be their reversed initials followed by their date of birth, which should be 6 or 5 digits.
- e.g. FM250711 (for 25<sup>th</sup> July 2011) or FM60711 (for 6<sup>th</sup> July 2011)
- If the first number is a single digit (i.e. before the 10<sup>th</sup>), then the date part of the password will be five digits.
- Further advice on usernames and passwords can be found in your year groups introduction to Teams letter


Once you are logged in, you will be able to access your class' learning resources by

clicking into your team.







- You will have different subgroups down the side for each subject.
- The 'General' subgroup will be used to provide you with the timetable each day.
- The other subgroups will have your learning resources (videos, worksheets, scaffolds, etc.)
- There is also a Mental Health and Wellbeing subgroup.



• The daily timetable will look a bit like this:




Each lesson will look a bit like this:




To access it, click 'View Assignment'.



Each assignment will look a bit like this and will contain instructions for the pupils.



Once pupils have completed their learning, they click 'Turn in'. This will notify the teacher that it has been completed.





### How do pupils get feedback?

Once pupils have 'turned in' their learning. Teachers will provide feedback on each piece of learning submitted. This will generally be feedback and next steps that will move the children on in their learning.

Pupils will be notified when feedback has been provided (notifications will appear in the 'Activity' tab



#### Transitioning from YouTube to Teams

- As we transition from YouTube to Teams, there will be a transition period of 1
  week week commencing 8<sup>th</sup> February. After half term we will be on Teams fully.
- During this time, we will continue posting videos on YouTube and providing feedback via emails as well as posting the same videos and learning materials on Teams.
- Due to workload, we will not be able to respond to emails on a daily basis although we will ensure that we respond at least once within the week.
- This ensures that should there be any problems, pupils can still access all learning for that week.
- After that week, we will be uploading all of our learning to the Teams platform and no longer using YouTube.

### Expectations for completing learning

- We would like pupils to complete as much of the learning for their Year group as possible each day. This ensures that they are still following the school curriculum without gaps in their knowledge/understanding.
- However, we do appreciate that it can be difficult to manage remote learning (particularly when parents/carers might be working at home and/or there are multiple siblings trying to access the remote learning).
