Remote Home Curriculum Arrangements – Year One

Dear Parents and Carers.

Following on from our previous correspondence regarding the decision to close your child's bubble, I am writing to you to provide guidance on the arrangements for how your child will be supported by the school in completing their learning at home. We want to ensure that all the children can access the curriculum during this time and will therefore be delivering the curriculum through different means.

We appreciate that it is difficult to replicate the classroom setting from home, but we aim to do this by continuing all our lessons through different formats. This means that as long as your child can access these resources, then they will be able to continue with the curriculum and will consequently have fewer gaps within their learning when they return to school.

The arrangements outlined within this letter will commence on Tuesday 5th January. This will give staff time to record lessons and ensure that systems are in place to support your child whilst they complete their lessons. Lessons

As previously mentioned, we want to ensure that we continue to provide our curriculum to your child during this time. As such, we have planned to deliver their weekly class lessons as they would occur normally within the weekly timetable.

Each year group will record their planned lesson within all areas of the curriculum, but these will be presented in the form of a video. These videos will include activities, pauses to consolidate and, in some cases, answers to questions, allowing children to self-review their own learning.

These videos can be accessed on the schools YouTube channel <u>here</u>. Each year group has their own playlist and the most recent lessons will be titled with the date of that lesson.



Lessons will be uploaded daily. If you miss a lesson then they can be re-watched but please keep up to date and establish these lessons as part of a daily routine, otherwise your child will miss essential curriculum learning. Please also ensure that you read daily with your child at home and question them about the book to keep building upon the comprehension skills we use in school.

If you or your child do not have access to a computer then please notify the school who will explore how we could best support you.
