#### Bikeability

Year 6 and Year 4 will be taking part in Level 1 Bikeability in Autumn Term 2021.

Bikeability Level 1 is a cycle training course, comprising of two hours of training which teaches all the cycle control skills needed before taking the bikes on the road. Children need to be able to ride a bike without stabilisers before attending this course.
