### **Year Four Trip to Hare Krishna Temple Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our R.E. curriculum this half term, Year Four are looking at the religion of Hinduism. To gain a further insight into the religion, we will be visiting the Hare Krishna Temple in Watford to take part in a guided tour and various immersive learning activities.

The visit will take place on **Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> June** and we will be travelling by coach so the children will need to be at school at **8.40am** on this date as the coach is due to depart promptly at 9.00am. We will be taking part in a guided tour, have a 'Cart Ride' and have the opportunity to dress up in traditional clothing. We will then be travelling to Aldenham Country Park to eat lunch. We are due to return to school at around 3.00pm, so the children can be collected at the usual time. We will of course contact you if there are any delays.

If your child normally has school lunches, we are able to provide a packed lunch for them for the trip at a cost of **£2.78** but if your child normally brings a packed lunch to school, they will need to ensure that they bring their lunch in a disposable bag and that no cans or glass bottles are provided for health and safety reasons.

The children will need to bring a bag to hold their water bottle and packed lunch and are required to wear their school uniform. Please also ensure that they are provided with an appropriate coat dependent on the weather on the day.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, which will be **£16.00**. This includes a donation to the Hare Krishna Temple, covers the cost of the workshops and transport. Payment is to be made via Arbor. Please be aware that insufficient contributions may mean that we need to cancel this trip. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the trip for your child. If you are experiencing difficulties meeting this payment, then please contact Mrs. Erdos via [email](mailto:) to discuss.
