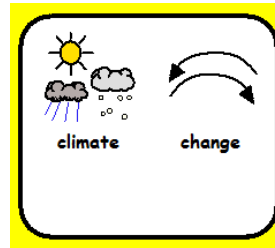

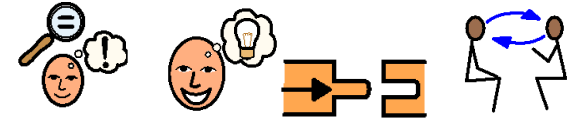

pollution	When gases, smoke and chemicals are sent into the environment in large doses that makes it harmful for people, animals and plants.
debate	A discussion between people who disagree about important subjects.
collective responsibility	All individuals responsible for the important matters.
climate change	A big difference in normal climate patterns over a long amount of time.
