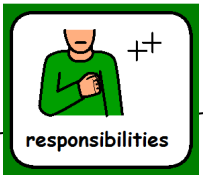

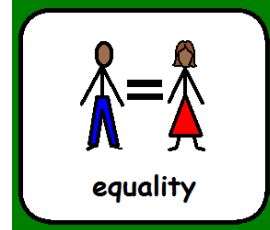
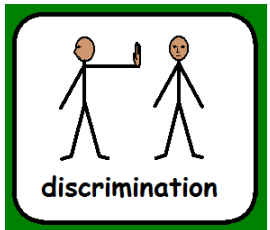

What are my rights and responsibilities?

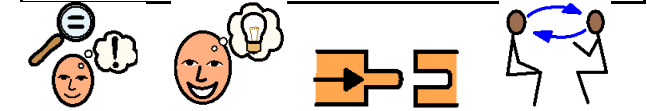


Do I know how to be respectful in different situations?



Key Vocabulary	Definition
rights	A moral or legal right to have something.
responsibilities	Doing the things we are supposed to do and accepting the positive or negative outcomes of our actions.
discrimination	When someone treats you differently or unfairly because of your age, race, gender, religion etc.
prejudice	An opinion that is formed without considering all the facts.
equality	Ensuring that people are not treated differently or less favourably on the basis of the protected characteristics (age, race, gender, disability or religion).

Key Outcomes

I understand my own privacy rights and when they might be broken.
I know how to be respectful in different situations.
I understand the consequences of behaviour (including online)
