
It is surrounded by the North Sea, the English Channel, the Celtic Sea, the Irish Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.

St Ives



What's the difference between a sea and an ocean?

An ocean is bigger than a sea — there are five oceans (the Arctic Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Pacific Ocean, the Indian Ocean and the Southern Ocean)! Seas are smaller, and normally surrounded by land.
