
<u>Italy</u>

The Tropics

Lines of latitude run from east to west (horizontally) around the Earth. The equator runs around the centre of the Earth. The Tropic of Cancer is a line of latitude in the Northern Hemisphere, and the Tropic of Capricorn is a line of latitude in the Southern Hemisphere.

<u>Europe</u>

Europe is a continent in the Northern Hemisphere. It is the continent that we live in. It is made up of 44 countries. Europe has a number of different climates — look at pages 66 and 67 in your atlas to explore them!

<u>Trade</u>

Countries can't grow or make everything that they need, so they often need to trade with each other by importing things they can't make and exporting things that other countries need. This has been happening throughout history. The UK's main exports are cars and precious metals, with most of them going to the USA and Germany. The UK's main imports are clothes and electronic machinery. The UK imports the most things from China.
