





Glossary	
Term	Definition
Stegosaurus	 Herbivore Poor eye sight but good sense of smell Scientists think it had two brains They have plates on their back
Triceratops	 Herbivore 3 horns used when fighting Bony frill to protect its neck Triceratops means 'three horned face'
Tyrannosaurus Rex	 Carnivore Bite more powerful than a lion Had a good sense of smell Tyrannosaurus Rex means 'tyrant lizard'
Velociraptor	 Carnivore Had a feather covering Second toe claw used to slash prey Velociraptor means 'speedy thief'
Pterodactyl	 Carnivore It could fly long distances They were flying reptiles not dinosaurs They had hollow bones to make them light
Plesiosaur	 Carnivore They couldn't breathe under water so had to come to the surface for air Plesiosaur means 'near lizard'












Powerful Knowledge


