### **Session Preferences**

Parents/carers will be asked for a preference upon application, however, preferences cannot be guaranteed and are subject to availability. You can apply for your child to attend either:

- > 5 x morning sessions (from 8.35-11.45am) or
- > 5 x afternoon sessions (from 12.15-3.15pm) for 15 hours provision
- > 5 x full days (from 8.35am-3.15pm) for 30 hours provision
- > Breakfast Club is available from 7.30-8.35am,
- Lunch is available from 11.45am-12.15pm and
- > After School sessions are available from 3.15-4.30pm

Prices for any of the paid sessions can be found in Appendix 1 of the Admissions Policy. All funded 3-4 year-olds are required to make a contribution toward consumable materials, this will appear on your half-termly invoice and must be paid ahead of attending the sessions.

Little Ridges has one major intake in September. Though we cannot guarantee any further availability in subsequent school terms, should a space become available, we will re-rank the register of interest and offer accordingly.





## **Funded Provision**



Universal Three/Four year-old funded places

All children are eligible for 15 hours free childcare from the term <u>following</u> their third birthday.

#### Extended Three/Four year-old funded places

Parents/carers need to check if they are eligible for the 30 hours' free childcare via the Government website. For 30 hour funded children attending full time, the lunch session is included at no additional charge as they stay all day. Parents will need to provide an eligibility code for the 30 hours extended entitlement and renew this eligibility ahead of each term. Failure to do so will lead to being invoiced in full.

- Story/ song time

#### Nap time

Children will take part in adult-directed activities as part of their daily focussed teaching, and adults will do this during CIL, so that it follows your child's interests.

Please ensure your child attends nursery punctually at the start of the day, and is collected promptly. This can be an anxious time for children!
