Addresses in Germany are written in a particular way:	For example:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Line 1: Form of Address (optional) Line 2: Recipient Line 3: Street name followed by property/house number Line 4: Postal code followed by town name Line 5: Country (if outside Germany) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Herrn Dieter WellhausenLansstraße 8 1D-11179 Berlin
It is not impolite to ask men or women their age in Germany.	

Key phrases	
<i>Wo ist... ?</i>	Where is...?
<i>Wie heißt du?</i>	What's your name?
<i>Ich heiße...</i>	My name is...
<i>Wie alt bist du?</i>	How old are you?
<i>Ich bin ... (Jahre alt).</i>	I am ... (years old).
<i>Wo wohnst du?</i>	Where do you live?
<i>Ich wohne in...</i>	I live in...
<i>in England /in Deutschland</i>	In England/Germany



Other words you might need...	
<i>das Haus / zu Hause</i>	the house / at home
<i>Ich habe dich!</i>	I've got you!
<i>gut / besser</i>	good / better
<i>(das) beste (Haus)</i>	(the) best (house)
<i>Könnt ihr mir helfen?</i>	Can you help me?

<i>die Kinder</i>	Children
<i>Warm</i>	Warm
<i>Heiß</i>	Hot
<i>Kalt</i>	Cold
<i>Eiskalt</i>	Ice cold
<i>das Geschenk</i>	Present
