Cultural Aspect
<p>Party games for birthdays</p> <p>German party game <i>Topfklopfen</i> (Tap a pot): One child is blindfolded. The other children sit in a circle on the floor. One child puts the pot upside down somewhere in the circle. Some sweets have been placed under the pot. The blindfolded child holds the wooden spoon and taps it gently trying to find the pot. The other children guide him/her by saying <i>heiß</i> (hot) or <i>kalt</i> (cold). Once the child taps on the pot, they get the sweets and another child has a turn.</p> <p>typical German party game called '<i>Schokoladen-essen</i>'. You need a bar of chocolate wrapped in lots of layers of news- paper, a knife, a fork, a dice, scarf, gloves and a hat. How to play: The children sit in a circle and take turns throwing the dice. As soon as one child has a six he/she has to put on the hat, scarf and gloves and try to unwrap and eat the chocolate using only a knife and fork. The other children continue to throw the dice. When another child throws a six, the first one has to take off the hat, scarf and gloves and the new child puts them on and tries to eat as much as possible of the chocolate only using knife and fork.
