Cultural Aspect - German schools

Children in Germany have to attend school between the ages of 6 and 15. They learn all together for the first 4 years (Grundschule). After that, teachers, the child and the parents decide which path is best for the child (Hauptschule, Realschule, Gymnasium). Education in state schools is free, although you have to pay for your own exercise books and stationary. There are only a few private schools. Usually they are free of charge. A normal school day is from 8am until 2pm which means that children have to do a lot of homework at home. There is no school uniform but children are expected to wear tidy and respectable clothes. In many primary schools children change into slippers before they enter their classroom. Most primary schools have a school garden; the subject is called Schulgarten and they teach the children about road safety (Verkehrserziehung).
