Year Three Trip to the Chiltern Open Air Museum Wednesday, 20th September 2023

Dear Parents and Carers.

As part of our thematic curriculum of 'Tribal Tales', this term Year Three are learning about the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age. To further develop the children's understanding of this topic we will be taking part in a trip to the Chiltern Open Air Museum. Whilst at the museum, the children will be taking part in an Iron Age and Stone Age workshop, where they will learn about what it was like to live during these times.

The visit will take place on **Wednesday**, 20th September and we will be travelling by coach so the children will need to be at school by **8.35am** on this date as the coach is due to depart after registration. We will be leaving the museum at 2.15pm to enable us to return to school in time for the children to be collected at the usual time of 3.20pm. We will of course contact you if there are any delays.

If your child normally has school lunches, we are able to provide a packed lunch for them for the trip at a cost of £3.15 or for free if your child is in receipt of Free School Meals. If your child normally brings a packed lunch to school, they will need to ensure that they bring their lunch in a disposable bag and that no cans or glass bottles are provided for health and safety reasons. Please also remember not to provide your child with anything that contains nuts.

The children will also need to bring a bag to hold their water bottle and packed lunch and are required to wear their school uniform. Please also ensure that they are provided with an appropriate coat dependent on the weather on the day and wellies if possible.

If your child requires any medication specific to the trip that cannot be administered at home (i.e., anti-sickness or hay fever medication), please be aware that you are required to complete the relevant paperwork ahead of the trip. Please contact Miss. Eaver for further information regarding this as we cannot accept medication when it is handed to Busy Living or straight to a member of staff. We must have the relevant paperwork in place.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, which will be £22.17. This includes entry to the museum and covers the cost of transport. Please be aware that insufficient contributions may mean that we need to cancel this trip. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the trip for your child. If you are experiencing difficulties meeting this payment, then please contact Mrs. Curtis Cross via email to discuss.

Please make payment via Arbor and complete this <u>form</u> to indicate if your child would like a packed lunch by 3.30pm on Wednesday, 13th September.



We will require parent/carer helpers on the day, so please kindly indicate on the form if you are available and willing to assist.
