## Enrichment Clubs - Spring Term 2024

Dear Parents and Carers.

This letter contains information regarding the enrichment clubs available in the Spring Term. These clubs will commence from Monday, 8th January and will end on the week commencing Monday, 11th March. Please note, there are no clubs the week commencing Monday, 5th February due to Pupil Learning Reviews taking place or the week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February due to half-term.

We kindly ask that you take the time to read and familiarise yourselves with the following key information.

- The booking system will open 6.00pm on Sunday, 26<sup>th</sup> November and will remain open until 6.00pm on Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> December and may be reopened should any spaces remain thereafter. We will of course communicate accordingly if this is the case.
- Due to limited spaces, parents/carers will only be allowed to book a maximum of **two** clubs and places will be allocated on a **first come**, **first served basis**. As mentioned above, should any spaces remain and bookings were to reopen, it's at that point that you can book your child on to more than two clubs.
- The cost will be £2.00 per child, per session which will go towards the cost of purchasing resources to run the clubs and any necessary equipment and consumables needed. You are required to pay for the full term upon booking.
- Please note that refunds **cannot** be given in the event of children not attending the clubs they have been allocated and no changes can be made due to the amount of admin work involved
- All pupils who are eligible for **Pupil Premium** will be given **one free club per term** in which a credit has already been added to their Arbor account in order to cover the cost. If parents/carers wish to sign-up for a second club, this will need to be paid for.
- Clubs run from the end of the school day up until **4.15pm** and children will need to be collected promptly from the **pick-up location**.
- For sports clubs where children may be required to change, please note that children are required to wear their PE kits. For clubs where PE lessons are the following day, we are happy for you to provide alternative clothing as we appreciate that PE kits cannot always be washed and returned in time.
- Children will no longer be given the opportunity to have a snack at the beginning or during the club due to timing. There is however a fruit/vegetable trolley available at school should a child sincerely require a snack.
- If children are continually collected late without good reason this may result in their place being withdrawn or if behaviour or engagement is poor.




- Children will **not** be able to be collected early from clubs as many clubs are led by a single member of staff.
- The school office is open until 4.30pm, so please collect any medication from there should you need to take it home.
- In the case of severe wet weather or heat, we will endeavour to continue to run clubs. However, this may mean that an alternative provision is provided indoors.

We appreciate that this is still a new system to you all and have therefore included some simple instructions below for you to follow.

- 1) Locate the 'Clubs' section on Arbor which can be found under 'Activities'.
- 2) Select a club in which your child is eligible to attend from the 'CHILD'S NAME can be registered for these clubs' section.
- 3) Ensure there are sufficient funds on your child's account by clicking the green 'top up account' button and follow the relevant steps. The cost for each Spring term club will be £16 as there will be 8 sessions at a cost of £2 each.
- 4) Once you have topped up your child's account, click the green 'register CHILD'S NAME for this club' button.
- 5) Choose membership by selecting Spring and click 'next'.
- 6) Select membership period by selecting Mon, 8 January Mon, 11 March 2024 (these dates are an example of a Monday club) and click 'next'.
- 7) Select session interval by selecting 15:15/20 16:15 and click 'next'.
- 8) The final step is to click the green 'register CHILD'S NAME for club' button.
