Arbor Text Messages

It has come to light that some parents and carers are sending us text messages to inform us about lateness or absence, we get no notifications of these messages so please be mindful when sending a text. We strongly encourage parents and carers to call the school or email in the first instance.

Absence and Sickness Procedures

Just a reminder that if your child is going to be absent from school/nursery, that you call the school on 01296 326320, and press option 1 to report the absence before 8.35am everyday your child is absent. This will give you the opportunity to leave a voicemail. If you are unable to call the school, then please email using absence@greenridgeacademy.co.uk.

Please note that if your child has a raised temperature, they must not come into school until at least 24 hours have passed without further symptoms or medication. If your child has had sickness or diarrhoea must not return to school until 48 hours have passed since the last episode.

This article highlights the importance of children being allowed to express their own thoughts, values and opinions. They can be guided by parents/carers and should be taught to respect others' differing opinions.



Safeguarding Tip of the Week

Physical Health

The World Health Organization defines physical health as: "A state of complete physical, mental and social wellbeing and not just the absence of illness or disease". Young people should aim for at least 60 minutes of physical activity per day.

The <u>NHS advise</u> that adolescent children should aim for two different types of physical activity:

1. Exercises that encourage them to move their whole body, breathe faster and feel warmer – known as aerobic exercise. 2. Exercises that strengthen muscles and bones, such as lifting weights or bodyweight exercises (like squats, lunges or push-ups).
