Christmas Lunch

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be able to offer a festive Christmas lunch for the children this year on Wednesday, 18th December. This is free of charge for Reception, Year One and Year Two pupils, due to the Universal Infant Free School Meals funding, however, Year Three, Four, Five and Six pupils will be required to pay the usual lunch cost of £3.30, unless your child is eligible for Free School Meals.

All children are welcome to have a Christmas lunch on this day, even if they normally bring a packed lunch into school but catering staff will need to know numbers in advance (as we are sure plenty of turkey will be required!) to ensure that they have adequate time to order and prepare enough food for everyone; please note that there will not be a jacket potato or chilled option on this day. The menu this year is as follows.

Therefore, we kindly ask that you indicate that your child will be having Christmas lunch by completing this <u>form</u> and order via your SchoolGrid account by 12.00pm on Wednesday, 20th November. Please contact the school office if you have not yet set up your SchoolGrid account and require a fresh password activation. Your child will not be able to claim their Christmas lunch on the day if you haven't pre-ordered it and we will assume your child will be having a packed lunch on that day if you do not complete the form as we cannot guarantee that we will have enough food.

Please note, that there will not be an 8.55am order deadline on Wednesday, 18th December as all meals must be ordered by 12.00pm on Wednesday, 20th November.
