Enrichment Clubs – Summer Term 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

This letter contains information regarding the enrichment clubs available in the Summer Term. These clubs will commence from **Tuesday 22nd April** and will end the week commencing **Monday, 14th July**.

Please note, there are **no** clubs on:

- **Monday 5th May** due to a bank holiday
- **Wednesday 21st May** due to staff training.
- **Wednesday 9th July** due to staff training.

We kindly ask that you take the time to read and familiarise yourselves with the following key information.

- The booking system will open **6.00pm** on **Sunday, 9th March** and will remain open until **6.00pm** on **Sunday, 30th March**. Please note, club leads are subject to change so we encourage you to book on based on the experience and not the staffing.
- The cost will be **£2.50 per child, per session** which will go towards the cost of purchasing resources to run the clubs and any necessary equipment and consumables needed. You are required to pay for the full term upon booking.
- Please note that refunds **cannot** be given in the event of children not attending the clubs they have been allocated and no changes can be made due to the amount of admin work involved. The only exception will be for any year 6 children attending the residential trip and Secondary School transition days to which we will follow up with parents/carers directly.
- Clubs run from the end of the school day up until **4.15pm** and children will need to be collected promptly from the pick-up location which will be shared at the end of the Spring Term ahead of summer clubs commencing.
- For sports clubs where children may be required to change, please note that children are required to wear their PE kits. For clubs where PE lessons are the following day, we are happy for you to provide alternative clothing as we appreciate that PE kits cannot always be washed and returned in time.
- If children are continually collected late without good reason or if behaviour or engagement is poor, this may result in their place being withdrawn.
- The school office is open until 4.30pm, so please collect any medication from there should you need to take it home.
- In the case of severe wet weather or heat, we will endeavour to continue to run clubs. However, this may mean that an alternative provision is provided indoors.

Please follow the below instructions when booking a club and be mindful of the recent payment changes.

- 1) Locate the '**Clubs**' section on Arbor which can be found under '**Activities**'.
- 2) Select a club in which your child is eligible to attend from the '**CHILD'S NAME can be registered for these clubs (2024/2025)**' section.
- 3) Click the **green** '**register CHILD'S NAME for this club**' button.
- 4) Select the membership within the dropdown box and click the **green** '**next**' button.
- 5) Select membership period by selecting **Tues, 22nd Apr – Tues, 15th July 2025** (these dates are an example of a Tuesday club) and click the **green** '**next**' button.
- 6) Click the box within the '**Review Membership Dates**' section and proceed with making payment by clicking the '**make payment**' button.

Payment is to be made via debit or credit card at the time of booking onto the club. You no longer need to top up your account on Arbor in advance. When booking a club, it will remain in your basket, and the place will not be confirmed until check out has been completed. If you are unable to checkout and pay for the club that is in your basket, this will be because capacity has been met and no spaces remain. As and when payment has been completed, we strongly encourage you to check on the clubs section on your child's Arbor profile to ensure that the booking has been confirmed.
