Walk to School Week & Bling Your Bike


As next week is Walk to School week, your child will be given the map below to complete for the house event.

Sharing Thoughts Freely


Children have the right to share freely with others what they learn, think and feel, by talking, drawing, writing or in any other way unless it harms other people.
