Dear Parents and Carers,

Our academy belongs to a wider group of local schools within Aylesbury as part of a sports partnership. The sports partnership is a group of primary schools which work together to give children increased opportunities to take part in inter-school sports and participate in different types of games and activities.

On **Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> June**, Year Five have been invited to take part in a school games roadshow with other local school children, which will take place at Stoke Mandeville Stadium. The event will take place between 10.00am and 1.00pm, and we will be travelling by coach to and from the venue.

As the event finishes at 1.00pm, the children will eat their lunch upon their return. As the kitchen will have closed by the time the children return, all children will be required to have a packed lunch on this day. If your child normally has school lunches, we are able to provide a packed lunch for them for the trip at the cost of £3.30. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, this cost will be covered.

The children will change into their PE kits before we leave and will change back into their school uniform upon their return. Please therefore ensure that your child has their PE kit in school on this day and that they bring a named water bottle and a substantial snack. Please also ensure that your child has sun cream applied, and is provided with a sun hat etc.

If your child requires any medication specific to the trip that cannot be administered at home (i.e., anti-sickness or hay fever medication), please be aware that you are required to complete the relevant paperwork ahead of the trip. Please contact Ms. West for further information regarding this as we cannot accept medication when it is handed to Busy Living or straight to a member of staff. We must have the relevant paperwork in place.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, which will be £3.63. This covers the cost of transport. Payment is to be made via Arbor. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the trip for your child. If you are experiencing difficulties meeting this payment, then please contact Mrs. Curtis-Cross via [email](#) to discuss.

Please make payment via Arbor and complete this [form](#) to indicate if your child would like a packed lunch by 6.00pm on **Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> June**.

We will also need some parent/carer volunteers on the day, if you are available to help out, please complete the [form](#) to indicate that you are willing to help. If we are inundated with offers, we may need to pick the names at random, you will however be informed either way by **Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> June**.

It promises to be a great morning, and a fantastic opportunity for the children to engage in different sports, as well as an opportunity to meet special guests, such as ex Olympic and Paralympic athletes.
