Sun Safe Schools

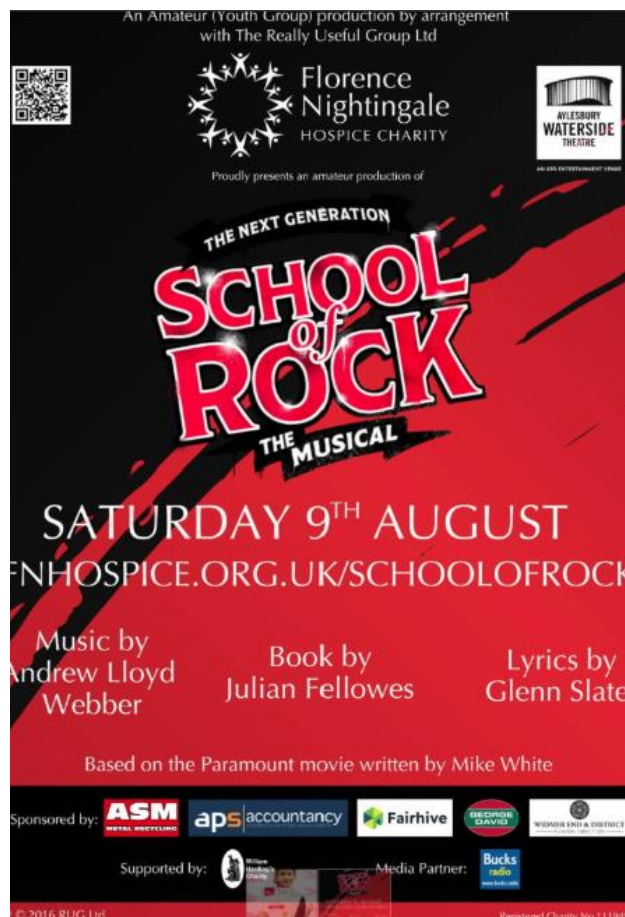
