## **Online Safety** Tip of the Week

#### Privacy and Security - KS1

Ask you child what a password is. Can they tell you what make a password strong? Should you have the same password for everything? Explain that passwords are there to keep personal information safe!

#### Privacy and Security - KS2

Often, once an app updates, many of its settings are reset back to the original ones. This could mean that any parental controls such as time limits may have been removed. Be sure to check regularly to ensure any parental controls are still implemented.

## Right of the Week Articles 10 & 22

#### Family Unification

Governments must respond quickly if a child or their parents apply to live together in the same country. If a child's parents live apart in different countries, the child has the right to visit and keep in contact with both of them

#### Refugee Children

If a child is a refugee, governments must provide them with appropriate protection and assistance to help them enjoy all the rights in the Convention. Governments must help refugee children who are separated from their parents to be reunited with them

## Sustainability Tip of the Week

#### Save Our Water!


