### School Lunch Pricing from September 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, we are very lucky to have our own purpose-built kitchen, to which [Herts Catering Ltd.](#) make all our school meals using fresh ingredients and are cooked on site daily. They provide the children with healthy, nutritious meals designed for children by a nutritionist. The menu is published to parents/carers on a regular basis so you can see what will be available on any given day. The menu consists of a variety of meat options, vegetarian options, jacket potato options with various fillings (for our creatures of habit!) and cold options (such as a sandwich/roll/baguette/wrap). HCL also celebrate various occasions and incorporate these into their menu planning, for example, Christmas and Children in Need etc.

We continue to be extremely satisfied with the meal provision at Green Ridge in conjunction with HCL and recognise that they do a fantastic job at keeping all our pupils fed daily. They are extremely accommodating, and the team really do know all the children personally! We are however writing to inform you that due to rising costs, school meals will increase to **£3.45** from September. Orders and payment is to continue to be made via SchoolGrid, to which you are required to have a direct debit in place.

As a reminder, as well as informing the school, it is vital that you also inform HCL directly should your child have any allergies or dietary requirements as they may require a special menu.
