#### Copyright and Ownership - KS1

Does your child understand what ownership is? Explain that anything that they create, belongs to them. When things are shared online, we need to check to see if we can use them but we mustn't claim them as our own.

#### <u>Copyright and Ownership – KS2</u>

Does your child know when they can legally use other people's pictures in their work?

Have them explore 'Creative Commons License' on Google images to that it appropriately filters photos that are suitable for reuse

## Right of the Week Articles 11 & 36

#### **Protection from Kidnapping**



Governments must stop children being taken out of the country when this is against the law – for example, being kidnapped by someone or held aboard by a

parent when the other parent does not agree.

#### **Protection from Exploitation**

Children have the right to be protected from all other kinds of exploitation (being taken advantage of), even if these are not specifically mentioned in this Convention.
