This month, we're proud to be celebrating and raising awareness of **Spina Bifida**, a condition that occurs when a baby's spinal cord doesn't develop properly in the womb, leaving a gap in the spine. This can lead to physical and neurological challenges as the child grows.

To help bring attention to this important cause, we're inviting all children to take part in a fun and meaningful Awareness Day on Wednesday, 1st October. We ask that they wear one item of clothing back to front—it could be a jumper, dress, or even trousers! By turning things around, we'll be symbolically bringing the "back" to the forefront of everyone's minds.

It's a simple gesture with a powerful message, and a great opportunity to talk with children about inclusion, understanding, and support for those living with Spina Bifida.
