**Year Six Trip to FSC Amersham  
Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Science learning of 'Classifying Living Things', after half-term Year Six will be taking part in a trip to FSC Amersham where we be completing a series of activities on this unit. FSC Amersham is a 'Field Studies' centre located within 30 hectares of mixed woodland, meadows and ponds which surround, making it an ideal place to explore different living things.

The visit will take place on **Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> October** and we will be travelling by coach. Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time as the coach is due to depart promptly at 9.15am. We are due to return to school before the end of the school day, so the children will be dismissed at the usual time of 3.20pm. We will of course contact you if there are any delays.

If your child normally has school lunches, we are able to provide a packed lunch for them at a cost of £3.45, or free if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium. If you will be providing a packed lunch, please ensure that items do **not** contain nuts and that no cans or glass bottles are provided for health and safety reasons.

Due to the nature of the trip, the children may get wet and/or muddy, therefore they should wear an appropriate coat/jacket (ideally waterproof!), warm clothes (such as jogging bottoms and a jumper), and are required to bring a pair of wellies. As we will be outside for much of the day, a hat, gloves and scarf are also advised. Wellies will not be worn on the coach, so please provide your child with a named plastic bag to bring them home in. The children will also need to bring a bag to hold their water bottle and packed lunch, as well as spare trousers and socks.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, which will be **£17.10**. Please be aware that insufficient contributions may mean that we need to cancel this trip. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the trip for your child. Please make payment via Arbor and complete this [form](#) to indicate if your child would like a packed lunch by the end of **Sunday, 5<sup>th</sup> October**. We will also need some parent/carers volunteers on the day, so if you are available to attend, please ensure that you complete the form to indicate that you are willing to help.
