## Online Safety Tip of the Week

### KS1 - Managing Online Information

Explain to your child that the internet can be a safe and reliable source of information. Remind them of childfriendly search engines (the one we recommend in school is Kiddle).

### KS2 - Managing Online Information

Ask your child what they would do if they saw a headline/article online and wanted to know if it was true or not. Guide them towards spotting 'fake news' and remind them to always check multiple sources and check with an adult before they share any information.
