Dear Parents and Carers,

At our school, we are committed to creating a welcoming, respectful, and inclusive environment for every child. As part of this commitment, we teach [Relationships Education](#), which is a compulsory part of the primary curriculum for all pupils in England.

Relationships Education helps children learn about a number of topics, including families and friendships; respect; similarities and differences between people and how to treat people fairly. It is taught through texts, assemblies and our PSHE curriculum.

Within this curriculum, children may learn that families can look different from one another and that, whilst we may have similarities, we are also unique. These discussions are always taught in an age-appropriate, sensitive, and factual way, focusing on respect and understanding.

We understand that families hold a wide range of beliefs, including religious beliefs, and we value the diversity within our school community. While parents do have the right to withdraw their child from sex education (which we do not teach at primary level beyond the science curriculum), there is **no right to withdraw from Relationships Education**, which includes learning about different types of families and the importance of treating everyone with respect. We believe that strong partnerships with parents help children thrive. For this reason, we have taken a constructive and thoughtful approach to sharing our curriculum plans. This has included providing advance information about the upcoming assembly, as requested at Parent Forum and offering opportunities for parents to view teaching materials to allow for clarity about what is being delivered.
