



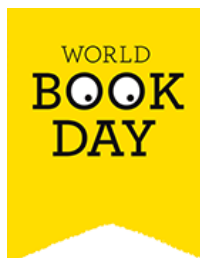

This year, World Book Day is being celebrated on **Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> March**. Reading is something that we really value at our school and World Book Day is an excellent way to celebrate this.

In school on **Thursday, 5<sup>th</sup> March**, we will be inviting the children to dress up as their favourite well-known book character. We want to assure you that there is **no** requirement to go out and purchase costumes – we would much rather the children come in as characters from books, which do not require you to purchase a brand-new outfit. Equally if your child would rather not dress up at all, there is no pressure, the children can come to school in their bed-time comfy pyjamas. This year there will not be a competition for dressing up as we would like the focus to be around enjoying and celebrating reading. To mark the day, the children will receive a World Book Day £1 book token. This token can be exchanged for any of the World Book Day £1 books, or it can be used to get £1 off any full-price book or audiobook (as long as the item costs at least £2.99) at participating booksellers. Your local bookseller may be on the high street or in a supermarket. The World Book Day £1 book token will be valid from Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> February to Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2026.
