Year Five DT Project Plea

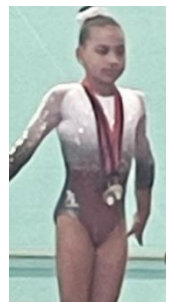

Self-image and Identity – KS1

Speak to your child about 'identity'. What is it? Do we have a different online identity to our in-person identity? Can people change their online identity? Ask your child if they can give three ways in which someone can change their identity online and discuss the impact of this.
