### Year Six SATs Information Parent/Carer Meeting Follow-Up

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following on from the SATs Information Evening on 28<sup>th</sup> April, I would like to highlight some important information from the meeting. The full presentation from this meeting can be found on the school website and attached to this email.

The SATs tests will take place during the week beginning Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026. The timetable for this will be:

Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> May – English Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. This consists of two tests; a Punctuation and Grammar paper (paper 1) which lasts for 45 minutes; and a short spelling test of 20 spellings (paper 2) which is not strictly timed, but should take approximately 15 minutes.

Tuesday, 12<sup>th</sup> May – English Reading Paper. This is one paper separated into 3 parts and lasts for 60 minutes.

Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> May – Maths Arithmetic (Paper 1) with a duration of 30 minutes and Maths Reasoning (Paper 2) with a duration of 40 minutes. There will be a break between these two test papers.

Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> May – Maths Reasoning (Paper 3) which lasts for 40 minutes.

These timings are for the main body of children and will be correct unless you have received a letter stating that your child has been awarded an additional 25% of time.

During SATs week we will be providing a breakfast club each day for the children where we will provide some breakfast items for them. These will include brioche rolls, croissants, yoghurt and fruit. We have a list of allergies in school and will ensure that all of these are catered for. Please speak to your class teacher if you wish to discuss this further.

Breakfast Club will start at 8am and the children will need to enter school through the upper KS2 gate where they will be met by a member of staff. **All pupils are required to be in school at 8am on the days that tests are taking place.** This is to allow us to ensure we can register and organise the children and start the tests promptly. All pupils are required to be in school during this week.

You will receive your child's SATs results with their end of year report. This will consist of:

- A raw score (total number of marks achieved for each paper);
- A scaled score;

- A judgement on if the National Standard has been met.

To help your child do as well as they are able, please make sure that they get plenty of sleep during SATs week, as well as a healthy diet and plenty of water. We will be completing some fun activities during the day as well as some short revision sessions to prepare them for the next day. Please remember:

- SATs only focus on what children know about Maths and English. They will not reflect how talented they are at science, geography, art, PE..., and they certainly won't highlight all of their amazing personal characteristics.
- SATs don't tell the whole story.
- Their results will say if they did or did not meet a certain standard but not necessarily by what margin. These thresholds change each year according to the overall national performance, so what was classed as 'meeting the expected standard' this year might not be the same as last year.
- SATs are only four days out of a whole Primary School career.

Please find, attached with this letter, the presentation slides about the tests that was given out at the meeting.
