Our academy belongs to a wider group of local schools within Aylesbury as part of a sports partnership. The sports partnership is a group of primary schools which work together to give children increased opportunities to take part in inter-school sports and participate in different types of games and activities.

We have arranged that on **Thursday, 14th May**, Year Two will be taking part in a multi-skills festival with other local school children, which will take place at The Aylesbury High School in Aylesbury. This festival will take place in the afternoon, and we will be travelling by coach for the children to and from the venue. The event will begin at 12:00pm and will finish at 2:00pm, so children will have a slightly earlier lunch at school before leaving for the event. To support with this, we are requesting that **all** children have a packed lunch on this day. We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the trip, which will be **£4.56**. This covers the cost of transport. Payments are to be made via Arbor. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the trip for your child. 

We must have the relevant paperwork in place.
