Year Six Enrichment Trip

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to let you know that next term we will be introducing a new enrichment trip for our Year Six pupils. This visit is designed to further strengthen our PSHE curriculum and support the children as they prepare for the increased independence that comes with moving to secondary school.

Throughout the day, pupils will take part in a range of practical activities linked to real-life scenarios, such as responding safely to a problem when no adult is immediately available, using public transport confidently and responsibly, and understanding how to behave as a positive member of the wider community.

This experience will give our Year Six children valuable opportunities to practise independence, build confidence, and apply the skills they have been developing in school. It will involve decision-making and responding positively to peer influences. Prior to the trips, the children will plan their routes (they will be using both a train and a bus to travel in and out of the town centre) and estimate the total cost of the day.

In addition to completing various scenario-based activities, the children will also: use the profits from their 11 Before 11 Perfect a Pitch promise to purchase an ice-cream from The Works; visit the local library; complete a 'detective treasure hunt' around the town centre; and enjoy a picnic lunch in the park. Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch on the day of their trip (Hawthorn: Monday, 29th June; Aspen: Wednesday, 1st July).

We are asking for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the visit, which will be £8.00. Please be aware that insufficient contributions may mean that we need to cancel this experience. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, the school will fund the cost of the visit for your child.
